Summer Patriot Games

- STOCKTON — Patriotism was on full display in Lincoln high's gymnasium Saturday as nearly 150 karate competitors marched into the gym carrying American flags prior to the start of the fourth annual Tibon's Summer Patriot In House Karate Championships.

The annual event coincides with the national Olympic Day, said event director Gene Tibon. During opening ceremonies he asked the competitors, "What are you doing on Olympic Day?" To which they shouted, "Karate!," followed by chants of "USA, USA, USA!"

"I think the show of patriotism touched the parents," Tibon said. "Through martial arts we try to give these kids an opportunity to understand what this country is going through.

"Stockton is a huge melting pot for martial arts," he added. "We try to develop a lot of youth by showing this as a positive alternative to gangs and drugs. "

More than 200 medals were awarded the competitors ages three to 60 from throughout the Central Valley. Joane Orbon, 20, a 2012 Bear Creek graduate, said she has been competing since she was four.

According to Tibon, Orbon is the first Stockton female to compete in the compete in the upcoming Pan American Games on July 23-26. She put on an exhibition match for Saturday's crowd.

"I feel like I was born to be something great, and I think this is what it is," Orbon said. "It also teaches you humbleness, perseverance and a never-ending amount of knowledge. It trains you internally and physically; I love everything about it."

Stockton's Kai Nguyen, 6, may not have been thrilled about the bloody lip he sustained during his match, but he still came away with a third-place medal. His younger brother Kaden, age 3, won a large gold medal in the Kata division, along with two participation medals.

"We love them to participate by showing their skills and having fun," said their father, Thomas Nguyen. "We wanted to wait until (Kaden) was five or six, but he pushed for it because he wanted to be like his brother. He is very focused, we were surprised by his attention span."

Brandon Aquino, 14, received a first place in the boys 14-15 kata division, and a second place in the weapons division. Aquino, who participates in roughly 20 tournaments a year, is a two-time national champion in the weapons division, said parents Ervic and Rochelle Aquino.

"(Kata) is the part I need the most work with, so I'm happy with what I did here," said Brandon Aquino, who is going to the Junior National Team Trials in Florida beginning July 15.

Karate is on the short list of possible Olympic events to be added in 2020, and Brandon said he'll be prepared if it comes into fruition.

"Team USA is the dream," Aquino said. "It'll take lots of training, practicing and fine-tuning my technique."






