


OLYMPIC DAY 2015

Sensei Justin Love Inducted into 2015 “Masters Hall of Fame” Congratulations!



Sensei Justin began training Goju Ryu Karate-Do at Tibon's Goju Ryu Fighting Arts dojo in 1993. Sensei Justin specializes in self-defense techniques against weapon and weaponless attacks situations and scenarios. He has studied many types of other martial arts styles and has a strong background in their fighting strategies. Sensei Justin brings a “real-world” approach and practical applications to the usage of Karate-do from his experience working in Law Enforcement and from the Military. In October 2014, Justin had the opportunity to train alongside and with the US Navy SEALs in Coronado, CA and certify as a top level National Law Enforcement defensive tactics instructor. Currently, Justin is one of the top regional Officer Safety Training Instructors for the California Highway Patrol and has taught hundreds of CHP Officers lifesaving empty hand techniques over his career. He has also taught several Karate Summer Camps emphasizing in children's self-defense and kidnap prevention. Sensei Justin's past career background includes an Honorable discharge from the US Marine Corps; Athletic Director/P.E. Teacher for Trinity Lutheran School and Correctional Officer for the San Joaquin County Sheriff's Department. Sensei Justin is currently a veteran Officer with the California Highway Patrol and been with the department for approximately 14 years. Currently he is training Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu under Charles Gracie at the Gracie Academy located in Tracy, CA. for the past 5 years and currently holds the of rank of Blue Belt.

From 2006-2008, Sensei Justin served as President for the Central Valley Karate Boosters Club, then a non-profit 503(c) organization dedicated to raising money to assist karate athletes in their endeavors to compete at the highest level. In 2009, Sensei Justin opened a non-profit leadership training and martial arts educational program called Victory Outreach Martial Arts Program (VOMAP). VOMAP partnered with the Stockton Victory Outreach Church and Tibon's Goju Ryu Fighting arts as a satellite affiliate that provides martial arts instruction & leadership training to at-risk youth in the inner city of Stockton, CA. Currently, VOMAP has approximately 40 active students and many students have been successful in graduating high school, getting out of gangs, preventing suicide, pursuing law enforcement careers and becoming model citizens and future leaders.

Tibon's Goju Ryu Karate Program

Go is Japanese for hard, *ju* means soft, and the phrase *goju ryu* refers to a type of karate, pioneered in 1930, that uses both types of movements. "Hard" generally refers to closed-hand attacks. "Soft" generally describes open-handed and circular motions used in defense or grappling, that Sensei Tibon is an expert in this form of Japanese Okinawan karate might be an understatement. He estimates that he's trained hundreds of athletes who went on to win national and international competitions, and his own trophy case isn't exactly lacking, either. Sensei Tibon has also lent his martial arts and instruction skills to an array of outreach organizations. On the mat at one of his studio's multiple locations, however, Sensei Tibon directs his focus completely to the lesson at hand, which can be anything from a weapons class or beginner classes for kids aged 4 to 12 and teen age adults.
