Tibon's Goju Ryu First Karate Camping Training North Shore Lake Tahoe

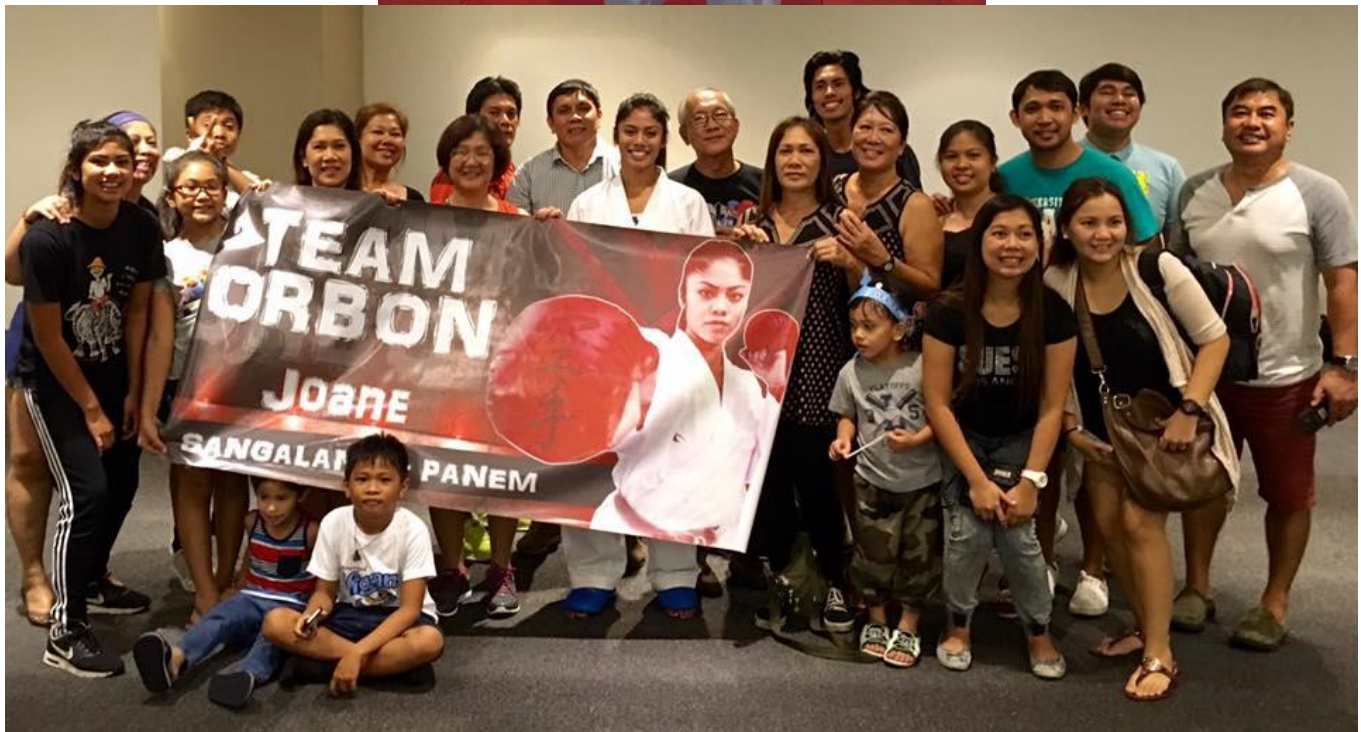


Tibon's Goju Ryu Fighting Arts first ever Karate Camping

In this course you learn the Department of Homeland Security endorsed method of response to an Active Shooter situation. Run, hide and fight.

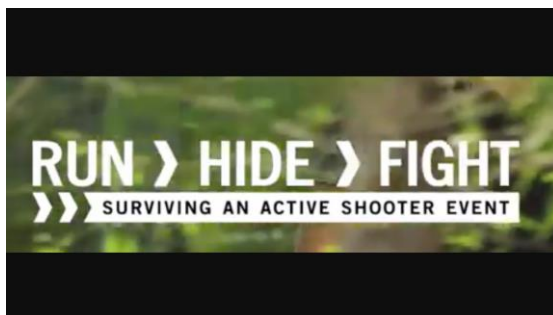
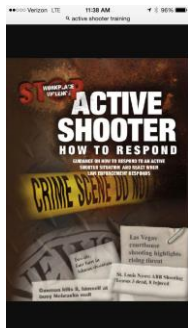

This course will be taught by Sensei Justin Love Sr. 3rd degree international certified black belt in Uchiage-Kai Goju Ryu with 24 years' experience. Sensei Justin also is a 15 year veteran of the California Highway Patrol and instructs Law Enforcement Officers in active shooter response tactics and tactical casualty care. Sensei Justin is a veteran of the U.S. Marines (active duty) and trained with the U.S. Navy SEALs & other top federal/ state law enforcement agencies. Sensei Justin has developed the current active shooter protocol response for the Stockton CHP Office and other State of California facilities. Sensei Justin was inducted into the 2015 class of the World Masters Martial Arts Hall of Fame.

Zoë's Hanson has a tumor on the pituitary gland. Craniopharyngioma is the medical term. Zoe has been battling this condition for a few months now. She has spent the last few months with her family at St. Jude's Hospital in Tennessee getting medical treatment. As we all know any type of life threatening medical conditions can take a toll on any family both mentally and financially. Last year the competition team booster club had our first fundraiser for breast cancer awareness.
